**AESCULUS PARVIFLORA** Bottlebrush Buckeye

Truly one of the best shrubs for late-spring and early-summer flower. Excellent plant for massing, clumping or placing in shrub borders.

Very effective when used under shade trees and in other shady areas.

The 8-12" long, bottle-brush shaped inflorescences contain hundreds of white, four-petaled flowers with pinkish white stamens that stand out an inch from the petals. Prefers acidic, well drained, moist soil but adapts easily.

**ARONIA ARBUTIFOLIA** Red Chokeberry

\*\*\*NATIVE\*\*\*

Most useful way for this species is to use for border, massing and in groups. Brilliant fruit display a sea of red in fall and winter. Perfect white or slightly reddish flowers occur in May.

Fragrant sumac is an irregular, spreading, deciduous shrub, 6-10 ft. tall, with velvety twigs and lower branches turned up at the tips. Glossy, somewhat blue-green, coarsely toothed, trifoliate leaves turn orange, red, purple and yellow in the fall. Yellowish catkin-like flowers precede dark-red berries which persist into March. A sprawling, small to medium-size shrub with aromatic foliage. Low grow cultivar stays 2' tall.

**RHUS TYPHINA** Staghorn Sumac

Staghorn is derived from the hair on the stems that look like a buck's antlers. The branches are covered with dense velvety hairs. It also produces clusters of crimson red fruits and its foliage turns shades of yellow, orange and scarlet in fall; often spectacular leaf out late in spring.

**Goldmound:** Is a low-mounded form with pink flowers in May and June and golden leaves throughout the growing season. The golden leaf color fades in summer to a yellow-green. Develops reasonable orangish-red fall color. Great addition to shrub and perennial borders, or any spot in full sun. H:2'W:3'

**Little Princess:** This selection has larger leaves and deeper pink flower color. Fall color is dark red. H:2'W:3'

\*\*\*NATIVE\*\*\* straight species & 'synnesvedt' (Chicago lustre), 'ralph sr' (autumn jazz), and 'christom' (blue muffin).

Valued for durability and utility, makes a good hedge or screen and is useful in groupings, masses and barriers. It has glossy dark green leaves, white flowers, and bluish fruit. It becomes a large, rounded shrub with spreading, finally arching branches. The lustrous dark green, leaves may turn yellow to red in fall. The white flowers come out in May and June. The blue-black fruit mature in September and October and are favorite food for birds.
